## **STREET MASTERS MEETING SUMMARY – November 21, 2016**

Members present: 19

Meeting called to order by Ann Curtis, President. A summary of the October minutes were adopted.

### **Old Business**

Plaques: Ryan Ellerton reported that four individuals had shown interest in purchasing a Street Masters plaque. The cost for an order of 10 to 24 would be \$26 per plaque; Ryan proposed ordering 15 plaques which would leave 11 for future purchase by new or current club members. A motion to purchase 15 plaques passed unanimously. Marlin Roseland proposed that the club sell the plaques for an additional fee allowing the club to make a little profit on these. Members supported this proposal but no final decision was made on a fee. Ryan will again solicit member's interest at the Christmas gathering before placing an order.

Fort Pierre Bi-Centennial: Fort Pierre Mayor Gloria Hansen suggested a Street Masters event in the Spring. Members proposed a September event, but the Fort Pierre event calendar already showed several events during that month so decided against September. Ryan Ellerton suggested the night before the June 10, 2017 Sioux Avenue Cruise as a possibility. The Cruise brings in many non-member vehicles so a Fort Pierre event during that time could include more vehicles than just club vehicles. Members are to keep thinking about this; a final decision will be made later.

Christmas Party: Members were reminded that reservations and payment were to be made for the December 3<sup>rd</sup> party. Ann Curtis was again asked to remind McClellands staff to make sure sufficient food is available on the buffet for all attending.

Election of Officers: Members were reminded that the election of officers takes place at the January club meeting. The process of nominating or volunteering for positions was reviewed. A nominating box will be available at the Christmas party; all submissions will be included in the January newsletter.

### **New Business:**

Goodguys: John Noyes reported that 3000 vehicles were at the Goodguys show and swap meet in Scottsdale, AZ

Club Group Activity: Cale Zickrick encouraged members to help each other after the yearly vehicle inspections by working together to get corrections made discovered during the inspections. It was suggestions that inspections could be scheduled on a Saturday then also work as a group on the needed corrections the same day. Another suggestion was that members get together to work on needed corrections before the inspection which could result in "clear" inspections for all vehicles. Group "working" events could also be scheduled during the year.
