Street Masters Minutes
April 17, 2017

Members Present: 30; one visitor.

President Marlin Roseland called the meeting to order.

A motion was made by Rodger Seefeldt, seconded by Cale Zickrick, to adopt the March 2017 minutes. A motion was made by Al Spangler, seconded by Rodger Seefeldt, to accept the treasures report and approve payment of a \$274.39 bill to Roxie Thielen; motion carried. The bill submitted included the purchase of Dam Run door prizes, a raffle item, trophy tops, and the annual corporate report fee.

Club accolades: Congratulations to Tom and Irma LeFaive on the arrival of their new granddaughter, Madeline Rose. Rodger Seefeldt introduced Josh Mose as a potential new club member.

Committee Reports:

- Dam Run – Chairman, Frank Eich, was not present, but Bob Thielen reported that registration can be held at the Lariat. Marlin R. indicated that the work will begin on the flyers.
- Public relations – Marlin Roseland continues to keep the website up-to-date and he is always looking for new photos of club vehicles. The Hot Rod Resources link has been added to our website. Let Marlin know if you notice any inappropriate sites from their link.
- Membership – Chairman, Rich Shangreaux, would like a list of projects/items the club does throughout the year to share with potential members. He will update the membership form adding our logo, website and facebook addresses, and his contact information. Suggested that we get pictures and news articles to the Capital Journal for continued promotion of the club. The information cards will also be available to all members; give Rich the names of potential members for him to contact.
- Scholarship – Chairman, Steve Brown, reported that six scholarship applications were received and reviewed by the scholarship committee. The committee recommendation is to award two \$500 scholarships with a third applicant as an alternate. Awardees must have at least a 2.5 GPA and must enroll in a postsecondary technology institute. As per the committee recommendation, a motion was made by Cale Zickrick, seconded by Rodger Seefeldt, to name two \$500 scholarship recipients with one alternate pending GPA and enrollment confirmation; motion carried. Steve B. will notify potential recipients and those not awarded. Potential awardees are: Jack Whaley, Fort Pierre, attending Lake Area Technical Institute; Addison Bendt, Kadoka, attending Western Dakota Technical Institute; and the alternate is Lane Olson, Gregory, attending Southeast Technical Institute.

Old Business:

- Name tags – Steve Brown will place the order for the magnetic name tags for those needing them. If you don't have one and your name was not on the list Steve distributed, let him know.
 - Club t-shirts – The shirts have arrived and are being distributed.
- NSRA safety inspections – Dave Hausmann worked with Dennis Ottenbacher to schedule the annual vehicle inspections for Saturday, May 13 at Exhaust Pros. It was agreed that inspections will begin at 1 p.m. with the family potluck at 5 p.m. Everyone is to bring a dish to pass and your own plates, silverware, beverage, and

lawn chair. Hausmann's will again supply ice cream and toppings for dessert.

- Dam Run t-shirts – Steve Harding reported that his daughter did not feel comfortable developing a design for the Dam Run t-shirts. Ryan Ellerton will continue to work with Two Lane Apparel out of Rapid City giving them permission to move forward with their artists working on the design. This will probably result in an increased cost for the shirts, but members believe the final result will still be within a reasonable price range.
- Dam Run liability – Marlin R. visited with attorney Chuck Poches and our liability insurance representative at Fischer Rounds regarding the need for a Right to Participate form for Dam Run participants. Both agreed it would be nice to have but not required. As long as our liability insurance is active, we should be OK without the additional form.
- Northridge Plaza show – The show is scheduled for April 21-23. Will begin moving vehicles in Friday evening at 6 p.m. Will get the ramps, stanchions, ropes and Street Masters' sign from storage.
 - Oahe Speedway – Karen England reported that the Speedway has secured sufficient sponsors to hold drag races Memorial Day weekend, May 27 & 28. If funds are available, races may also be held Labor Day weekend. The May races will also include muscle cars; good payouts on all races.
 - Fort Pierre Bi-Centennial – No new information.

New Business:

- Cruise schedule – Coordinator, Cale Zickrick, has scheduled cruise nights to meet, eat, & cruise on May 17 at Taco Johns and May 24 at Big Toms.
- Oahe Days – Street Masters will participate in the Oahe Days parade and show on June 22. The vehicle show on the causeway will be from 5 to 9 p.m. after the parade.
- By-laws – Marlin Roseland plans to have the officers' work on the needed revisions to the by-laws which will then be presented to the membership for consideration.
