 - Bob's Steakhouse cruise took place on a beautiful evening with 13 club vehicles traveling to Gettysburg. A handful of members from the Gettysburg car club joined us for dinner.
 - Some members participated in the medical fundraiser for Brad Brake of Aberdeen who is battling cancer. It was a cold rainy day but the event drew a large crowd for the vehicle show and huge auction. The club donated \$100 to Brad plus one registration fee certificate to the 2018 Dam Run was included in the auction.
